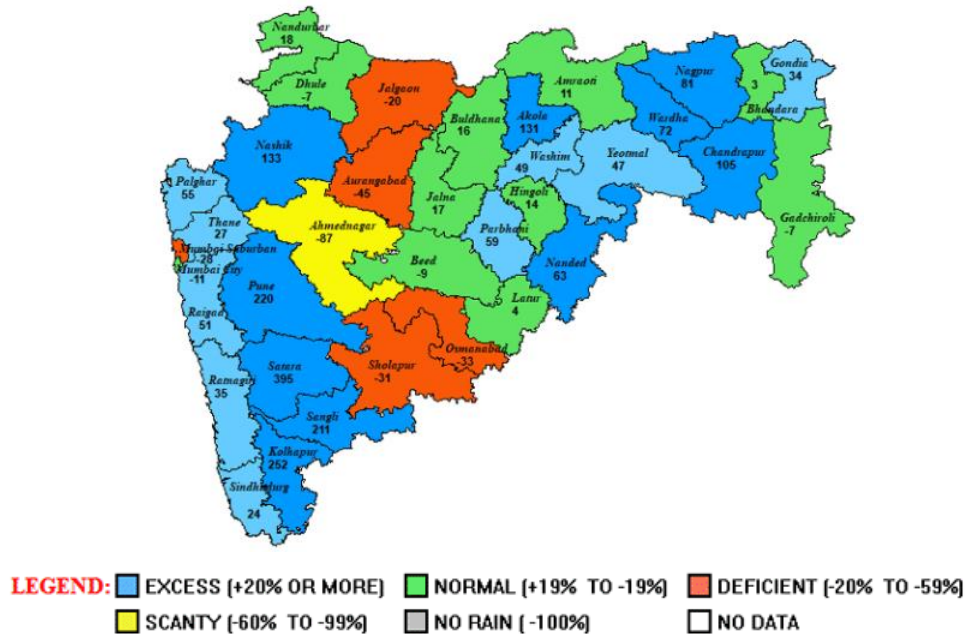
**EXTENDED RANGE FORECAST FOR KONKAN, MADHYA MAHARASHTRA AND
MARATHWADA**

OBSERVED WEATHER DURING PAST WEEK (22-28 July 2021):

Heavy to very heavy rainfall occurred in the districts of Konkan, Madhya Maharashtra and Marathwada during the past week. Extremely heavy rainfall also occurred at isolated places in the districts of Konkan and at a few places in the ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra.

Rainfall Scenario during the past week:

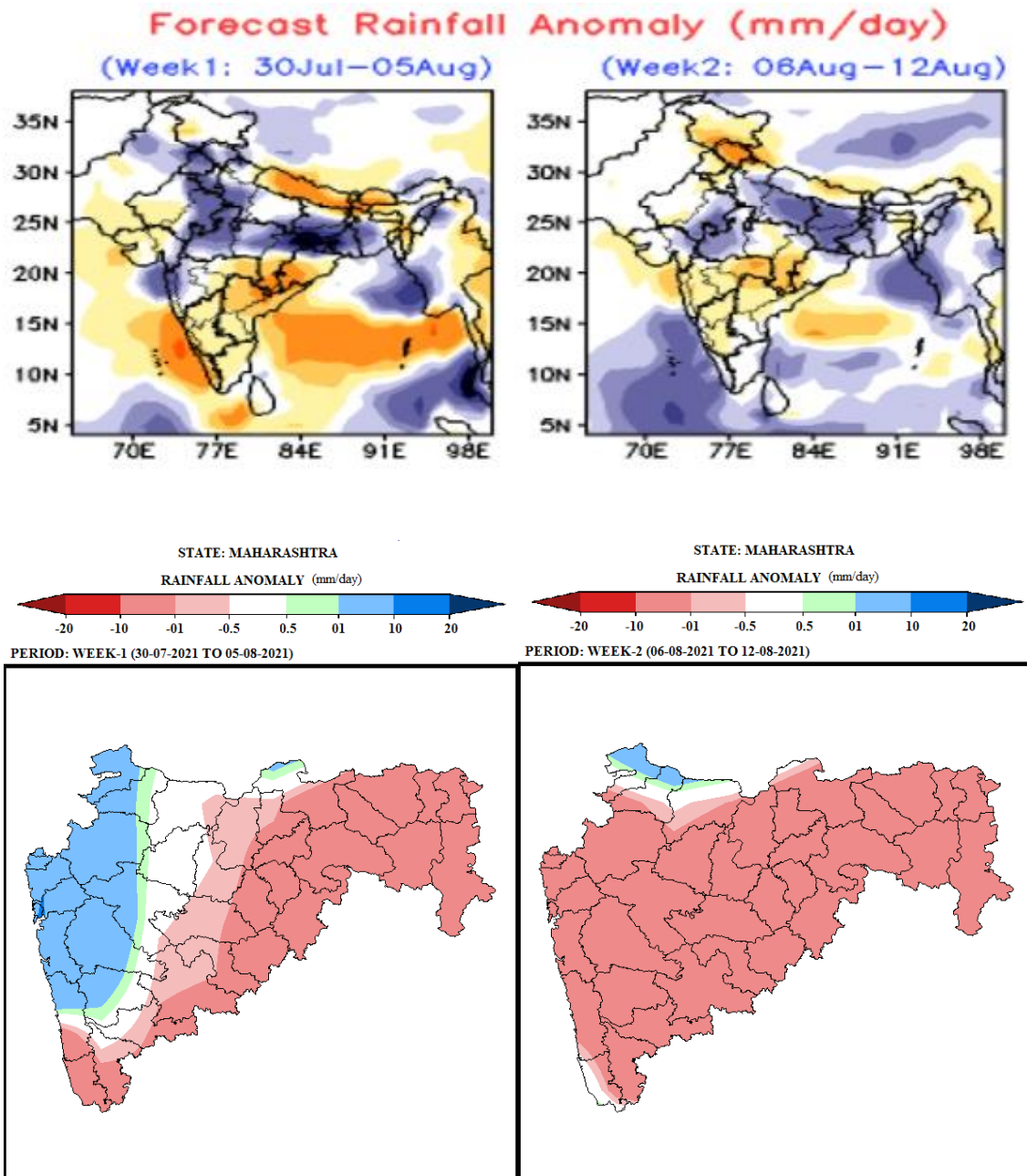
Percentage departure of rainfall from long period average for the different subdivision during the recent past week (Ending on 28.07.2021) is shown in the figure below:

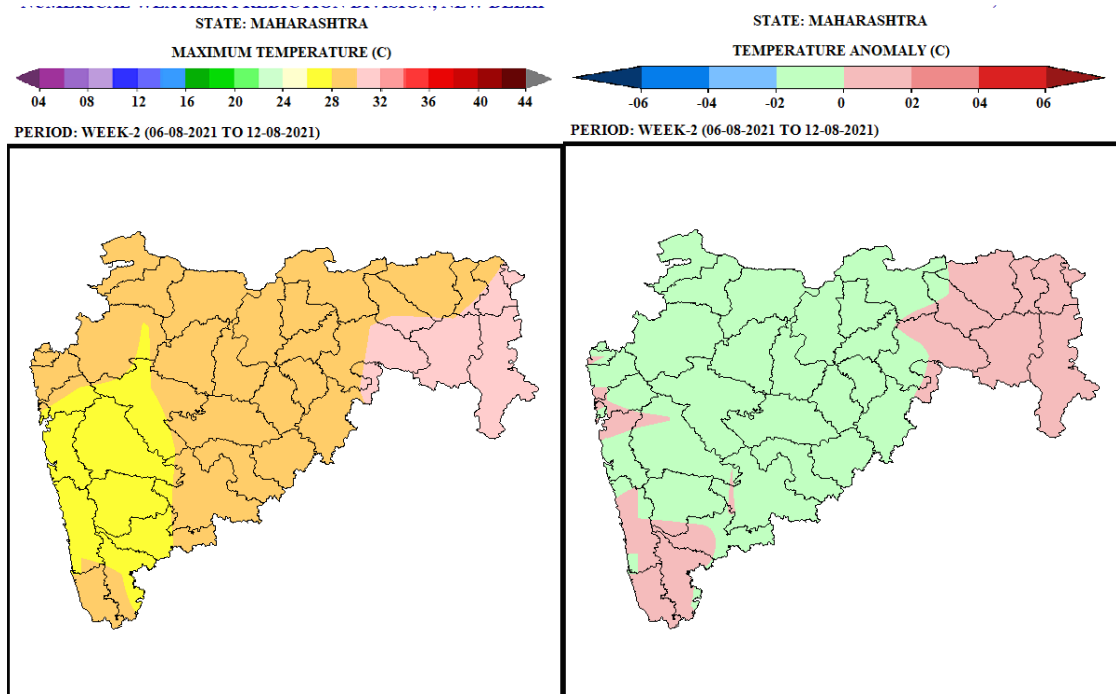
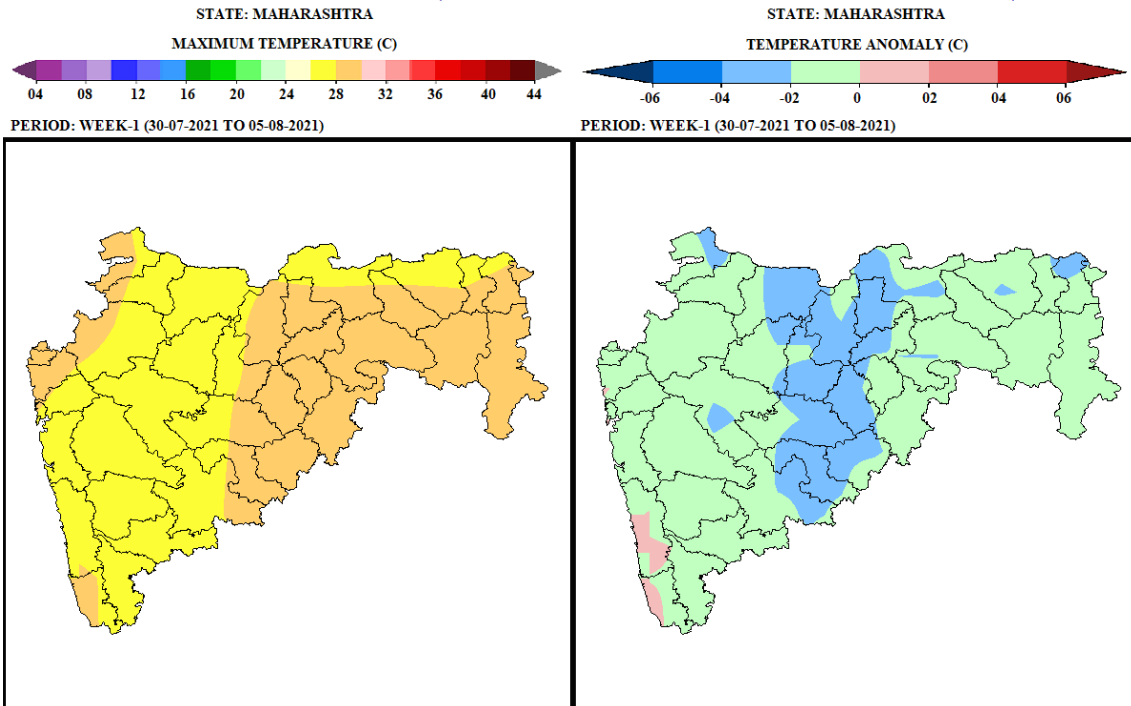
1. Rainfall:

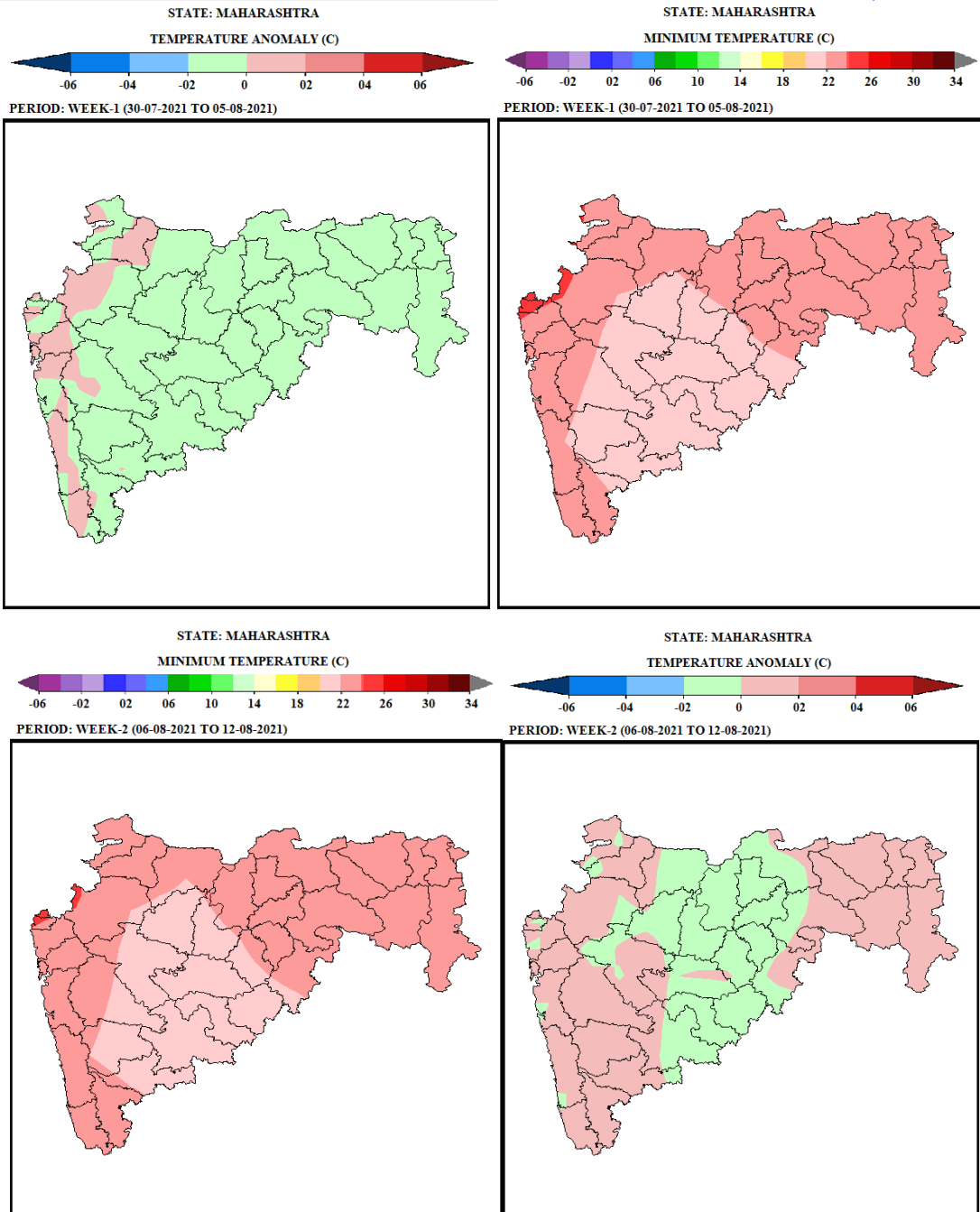
2. Maximum Temperature:

Week 1	Normal to below normal	Normal to below normal.	Below normal to appreciably below normal
Week 2	Normal to above normal over parts of south Konkan rest normal over most parts	Normal to below normal over most parts	Normal to below normal



3. Minimum Temperature:

	Konkan	Madhya Maharashtra	Marathwada
Week 1	Normal to above normal	Normal to below normal	Below normal
Week 2	Normal to above normal	Normal to above normal over most districts except the south- eastern parts of the subdivision	Normal to below normal over southern parts.



FORECAST FOR EXTREME WEATHER:

Heavy Rainfall Warnings:

Heavy rainfall very likely at isolated places in the districts of Konkan and adjoining ghat areas of Madhya Maharashtra during week 1.

Legends:

Maximum (Tmax) and Minimum Temperature (Tmin) Departure

Distribution	Departure from Mean
Markedly Below Normal	-5.0°C or less
Appreciably Below Normal	-3.1°C to -5.0°C
Below Normal	-1.6°C to -3.0°C
Normal	-1.5°C to -1.5°C
Above Normal	1.6°C to 3.0°C
Appreciably Above Normal	3.1°C to 5.0°C
Markedly Above Normal	5.0°C or more
