

REGIONAL WEATHER INFERENCE

23.06.2022

MUMBAI MID DAY INFERENCE:

The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) continues to pass through Lat. 22°N/ Long.60°E, Lat. 22°N/Long. 65°E, Porbandar, Baroda, Shivpuri, Rewa, Churk, 27.0°N/84°E.

ARABIAN SEA INFERENCE:

The off-shore trough at mean sea level from south Maharashtra coast to north Kerala coast now runs from south Gujarat coast to Karnataka coast.

A cyclonic circulation lies over Eastcentral Arabian Sea off Maharashtra coast between 3.1 & 4.5 km above mean sea level.

Southwest monsoon moderate to strong over Central, North East and Southwest Arabian sea and moderate over Southeast Arabian sea to the South of Lat 22 Deg N.

Weather seasonal over rest Arabian Sea.

REGIONAL INFERENCE:

Generally Westerly winds prevail in the lower level over the region.

40.6 Deg C recorded at Bhuj was the highest maximum temperature over the region.
